Indian Creek Guest Ranch is located about 4,000 feet above sea level. Summer daytime temperatures can be very warm, in the eighties and nineties, with crisp morning temperatures and cool evenings. Guests should be prepared for occasional summer thundershowers. The county is steep and rugged, hikers and riders need to be prepared. The ranch atmosphere is casual; dress should include comfortable, outdoor apparel. A limited amount of beer and wine is served with hors d'oeuvres and dinner. If desired you may bring your own alcoholic beverages

### **Please bring the following:**

- Lightweight jacket, preferably wool or fleece
- Lightweight rain jacket
- Sun hat or cap
- Sunscreen
- A liter or quart size water bottle
- Camera
- Lightweight day pack
- Small flashlight
- Binoculars (optional)
- Personal fishing gear (optional)

### **For hiking**

- Bring hiking boots, with ankle support and soles with good traction

### **For whitewater rafting**

- Bring nylon or lightweight (not cotton) shorts or swimsuit
- Fleece jacket

### **For horseback riding**

- *We require that you wear sturdy shoes or boots with a riding heel and long pants*
- Helmets are available upon request

### **For fishing**

Idaho Department of Fish and Game requires that you have in your possession a valid Idaho fishing license when fishing public waters. Our pond does not require a license. Fishing licenses can be purchased in North Fork near the ranch.

\*Kennel accommodations are available in Salmon for your pets.

\*Guest ranch lodge and cabins are non-smoking.
